

**CHAPTER 23 - UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR NUMBERING PROPERTIES AND
PRINCIPAL BUILDINGS IN DUNN COUNTY**

23.01 AUTHORITY. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 59.54(4), Wisconsin Statutes, and incorporates said statute herein by reference, including amendments and successor statutes.

23.02 UNIFORM NUMBERING SYSTEM. A uniform system of numbering properties and principal buildings as shown on maps identified by the title of each township, which are on file in the Department of Administration is hereby adopted for use in Dunn County, Wisconsin. These maps and all explanatory matter thereon are hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance.

23.03 ASSIGNMENT OF NUMBERS.

- (a) All properties or parcels of land in unincorporated areas within the boundaries of Dunn County, Wisconsin, shall hereafter be identified by the uniform numbering system adopted herein, provided: all existing numbers of property and buildings not now in conformity with provisions of this ordinance shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
- (b) All properties on the east side of north-south streets and all properties on the south side of east-west avenues shall be assigned even numbers. All properties on the west side of north-south streets and all properties on the north side of east-west avenues shall be assigned odd numbers. An appropriate prefix of "N" or "E" will precede the number.
- (c) Each principal building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is located. In case a principal building is occupied by more than one business or family dwelling unit, each separate front entrance of such principal building shall bear a separate number.
- (d) Signs indicating the official numbers of each principal building or each front entrance to such building shall be uniform throughout the county and shall be posted on the right-of-way or in a manner as to be visible in either direction from the street or avenue on which the property is located.

23.04 ADMINISTRATION.

- (a) The Department of Administration shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system.
- (b) The Department of Administration shall assign the numbers for newly subdivided properties or change to multiple use of existing properties in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance. At the request of a property owner, numbers may be assigned for improved but unoccupied properties.
- (c) The cost of assigning and installing the numbers for properties described in section 23.03(c), and for replacement of any existing signs shall be charged to the property owner at a fee to be determined by the Department of Administration.

23.05 PENALTIES. Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500. Each separate day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
