DUNN COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASS

April 18, 2022

The Board of Canvassers met in the Community Services Building, Room 101 on Monday, April 18, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. to recount the April 5, 2022 Spring Election results for Dunn County Supervisor Districts 2 and 9. Members present were Andrew Mercil-County Clerk, Diane Rust, and Vicki Price.

The ballot bags were opened by municipality, sorted by candidate, and hand counted by Diane Rust. The tally of votes was logged by Andrew Mercil and Vickie Price. Total votes for each office was tallied and verified against the election night returns.

Recount tallies were as follows:

<u>District 2</u>	T. New Haven	T. Sheridan	T. Tiffany	Total
David Bartlett:	49 48	51	33	133 132
Patrick Breslin:	68 69	19	50	137 138

First hand count for the Town of New Haven vote count differed from Board of Canvass result with 49 votes for Bartlett and 68 votes for Breslin. Board of Canvass had 48 votes Bartlett and 69 votes Breslin.

First hand count for the Town of Stanton vote count differed from Board of Canvass results with 78 votes for Quinn and 79 votes for Chich. Board of Canvass had 79 votes for Quinn and 78 votes for Chich.

Mr. Quinn requested a second hand count of the Town of Stanton. The second hand count found the initial numbers from Board of Canvass, and the ImageCast Evolution tape results were accurate and that Thomas Quinn received 79 votes and James Chich received 78 votes.

The Board of Canvass decided to do a second hand count of the Town of New Haven results. The second hand count found the initial numbers from Board of Canvass, and the ImageCast Evolution tape results were accurate and that David Bartlett received 48 votes and Patrick Breslin received 69 votes.

The Board of Canvass certified the recount with vote totals as follows:

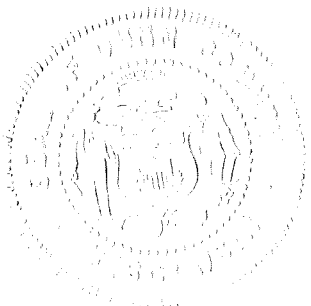
