The **mission** of the Dunn County Criminal Justice Collaborating Council (CJCC) is to collaborate between stakeholders to improve the effectiveness of Dunn County's criminal justice system.

The **vision** of the CJCC is to improve the criminal justice system for all Dunn County residents.

2008: COUNTY BOARD RESOLUTION CREATES CJCC

The Dunn County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution formally creating the Dunn County Criminal Justice Collaborating Council.



2008: TREATMENT COURT

Dunn County Diversion Court, later renamed Treatment Court, was created. This evidence-based court monitored program serves individuals at high risk to recidivate and high need for treatment. Part time staff contracted with levy funds.



2014-2015: STRATEGIC PLAN - RETOOL

Changed the structure of the CJCC with focus on Evidence-Based Decision Making (EBDM) Initiative and the Stepping Up Initiative to reduce the prevalence of significant mental illness in jail. EBDM Criminal Justice Systems Map completed with charge targets identified.



2016: Data Driven Justice

Signed onto the national Data Driven Justice initiative. Began, CJCC monthly and annual criminal justice data Smashboards started.



2016: PRE-CHARGE DIVERSION PROGRAM

Pre-Charge Diversion Program started under the Dunn County District Attorney's Office.



2016: LAW ENFORCEMENT PROXY

Dunn County Law Enforcement Proxy tool implemented to aid officer decision to cite, arrest, or detain.



2018: FAMILY TREATMENT COURT PILOT GRANT

State grant received to pilot a Family Treatment Court (FTC) program in Dunn County. FTC participants began in August 2019.



2017: POST-CHARGE DIVERSION PROGRAM & ASSESSMENT PROTOCOL

State Treatment Alternatives & Diversion (TAD) grant awarded to implement a post-charge diversion program, the Treatment Opportunity Program (TOP), and to implement pretrial services with universal assessment protocol screening for pretrial risk, mental health, and substance use needs.



2018: JAIL TO COMMUNITY REENTRY SERVICES

State grant for Reentry peer support services for people leaving jail.



2020: SIM Mapping

Sequential Intercept Mapping (SIM) with national technical advisors identifying housing and mental health crisis system as major issues of concern.



2020-2021: COVID GRANTS

State COVID grants received for courtroom safety and technology upgrades and Sheriff's Department laptops and other technology.



2020: Drug Endangered Children (DEC) – Handle with Care

DEC training for criminal justice staff, local area school districts, and Prevea. "Handle with Care" program initiated to notify schools of a traumatic event.



2022-2023: JAIL MAT GRANTS

- DOJ grant received to implement a medication assisted treatment (MAT) program in jail
- Licensed Substance Use Disorder Counselor hired in the jail
- Additional MAT grants received from state DHS



2020: "Make the Safe Choice"

CJCC held community forums and distributed posters to all drinking establishments in the County on the costs of an OWI with resources to make the safe choice to get home.



2022: PROJECT HOPE

State law enforcement deflection and diversion grant received to expand the City of Menomonie's Project Hope initiative countywide.



2023: TAD EXPANSION GRANT

Four-year state TAD expansion grant received to expand the TOP diversion program. Dunn County is recognized as a state leader in area of diversion.



2023: PROJECT HOPE LAW ENFORCEMENT DEFLECTION PROGRAM KICKSOFF

Behavioral Health Officer (BHO) embedded in the Sheriff's Office and partnering with Menomonie Police Department's Project Hope Quick Response Team (QRT) with Menomonie Fire and Dunn County Human Services to respond and deflect people in need of treatment to community-based resources.



2023: FEDERAL FTC GRANT

Three-year federal Family Treatment Court (FTC) grant received to enhance existing program.
